

**St. Therese Catholic School
Parent Contract 2008-2009 School Year**

Please initial each section to indicate your awareness, understanding and agreement to the following:

I, _____ understand that I have a financial obligation to pay the charges below to the school for the full academic year and that no portion of any charges listed below once paid shall be refunded for any reason.

- _____ 1) **Registration Fee:** \$250.00 per student, per year not to exceed \$1,000.00 per family.
(Note: A family is defined as a single unit housed under one roof where children share the same parent/guardian who has legal custody and financial responsibility for the children.)
- _____ **Current Students:** \$300.00 per student not to exceed \$1,200 per family after February 4, 2008 (late registration)
- _____ 2) **Tuition:** I agree to pay tuition in full, or participate in the F.A.C.T.S. Tuition Payment Program with automatic deductions for tuition from my savings or checking account, Discover or Mastercard. I will assume financial responsibility by signing the Financial Agreement.
- _____ 3) **School Raffle:** I will provide a check/money order made out to St. Therese School for \$300 on Orientation Day in August. I will receive \$300 worth of raffle tickets, which I may choose to sell to reimburse myself. If I wish not to sell the tickets, I will give this \$300 in place of my participation in this fundraiser.
- _____ 4) **Parish Subsidy Fee:** \$300.00 per student, per year. I understand that if my home parish denies my parish subsidy, that it is my obligation to pay this subsidy in full. Due December 1, 2008.
- _____ 5) I agree to participate in the school's **Parent Work Service Program** with an annual minimum of 20 hours of work service, per family. A fee of \$10 per hour will be assessed if hours are not completed.
- _____ 6) I have read and understand the Archdiocesan Policy on non-payment of tuition and fees as shown below:
Tuition that is not prepaid must be paid in monthly installments. Tuition is considered delinquent 10 days after payment is due. Should the tuition remain past due for two consecutive months, on the 10th day after the due date in the second month, the student is considered ineligible to return to classes until the tuition and fines are paid in full. Should the tuition remain past due by the 15th day after the due date in the second month, the student is to be disenrolled from the school.
